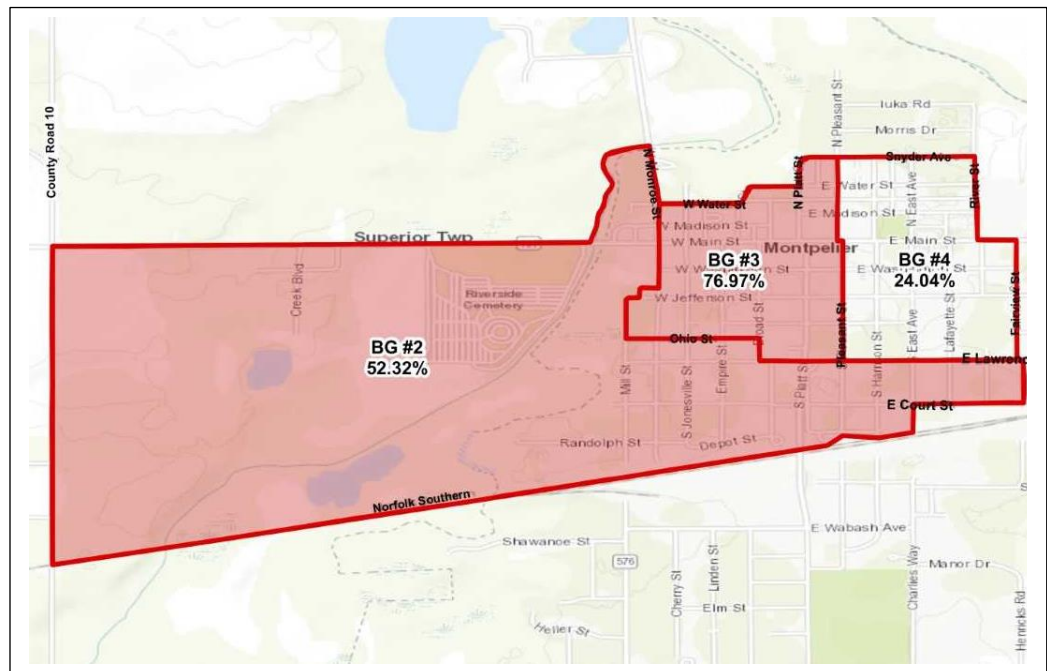




Community Needs Survey

The Village of Montpelier will be applying for a Neighborhood Revitalization Grant (NRG) from the State of Ohio through Williams County targeting improvements for a very specific portion of the village, areas determined by the HUD to be eligible. The purpose of this grant is to fund community improvement projects that will have a significant impact and benefit the area shown in red on the map below. Your input is critical.
